Hello ,

I am writing to express my opposition to the plans to build 1400 homes at the site of Brooklands Farm , South Street Whitstable .

There is already significant overdevelopment in the area with no corresponding investment in additional infrastructure - such as hospitals , doctors surgery's , schools, roads and drainage / water treatment .

Why are all these additional homes needed ? It stinks of greed and profit rather than meeting the needs of local people and considering the environment and functionality of local infrastructure .

House building in recent years is ruining east Kent . Roads are congested , the sea and rivers are polluted with sewage discharge , flood alerts are frequent due to increased ground water run off (exacerbated by local over development) and it's impossible to see a doctor or get a hospital referral within a reasonable timeframe .

Your planning proposals are worsening the situation and I wholeheartedly object to them .
