I am writing about the Canterbury District Local Plan and specifically my objections to C12 - land north of Canterbury currently owned by UKC with plans for a settlement of 2000 houses.

My main objection is due to the road. Both access roads will cause a huge increase in traffic which we already know from previous reports, will create unsustainable pollution, traffic and congestion. In fact, it is already described in the Land assessment as a 'car dependent development'.
