Dear Sir or Madam,

I sincerely OBJECT to the proposed development for Brooklands farm and wish to voice my opinions as a resident of Whitstable. Our present infrastructure cannot support this number of new houses . It can barely support the community at present . This development , alongside the building proposed at Blean will mean more traffic , more sewage , more flooding more people , and less facilities available to support them .
