Already our area is very over developed, it cannot cope with this unbelievably large Proposed development.

The huge seemingly unfixable sewage problem that already exists polluting our local sea & rivers by SE Water will be made uncontrollably worse.

This site already has flood issues which will cause huge problems to adjoining areas should this development with 1400 houses, schools & industrial units proceed.

The air & noise pollution created by the thousands of cars & heavy commercial vehicles using this site while being constructed & when completed will be extreme, & totally against what this country is striving to achieve. Also the light pollution will be dire.

We don't have enough doctors & dentists to accommodate our existing residents as firmly stated by Dr.Ribchester of Estuary View on the 24thApril at the meeting at the WHITSTABLE Umbrella Centre, also stating they're finding it impossible to recruit more doctors & other medical staff. How on earth are thousands of possible new residents going to get NHS treatment, our hospitals are already overloaded & cutting many services.

The access points mentioned are another major issue, how can the likes of LISMORE Road become an access point, it is not a main thoroughfare to cope with tirade of commercial building vehicles & workers cars & subsequently thousands of new residents cars etc. & accessed via CLOVER RISE again totally unsustainable, it will destroy all the adjoining residential areas.

WHITSTABLE,S infrastructure is already at breaking point, traffic chaos continually exists, the appalling state of the roads with very frequent accidents due to an unsafe clogged network in Whistable with no Police station or even a maned police office, having been closed several years ago.
