I object most strongly regarding the Council plan to build 1880 new homes on the Brooklands Farm development for the following reasons! - The council must be made.

1. This will impact most seriously on resources and the community.
2. It is madness to make a new road at Chestfield on to what is an already major road and an Accident Black Spot.
3. These new homes will put hundreds of more cars on the road
4. There was so many accidents at the junction

of Church Street end Thanet Way when we first moved to South Street that the council closed off our exit to the Thanet Way. This was because of the cost of emergency services, ambulance, police and fire brigade always being called. One accident involved the Air Ambulance because a pregnant woman was involved. It landed on the corner of Brookland Farm. It must have cost a lot to call it out.

5. To build all these houses on the field site will shut out our view across the farmland and we will not have crops growing and being attended to. Also not to see the crops being harvested etc. We already suffer from saturated back gardens with the water running down the hillside. This will get worse.

6. Properties in South Street will be devalued due to no views over Brookland's Farmland open space,

only a concrete jungle.

1 More loss of agriculture land to grow crops which will be needed in the future.

More flooding and loss of countryside and wildlife. More health care needed for Doctors, Dentists and schools.

More pollution with more cars and not a very good bus service. Whitstable will be a concrete jungle. Sewage services will only get worse, with more discharged into the sea.
