I strongly object to the proposal to designate building within Blean Woods as part of this local plan

The main grounds for my objections are:

1. Significant loss of this long established habitat with consequent impact on the flora, fauna and public amenity. Simply irreplaceable
2. Lack of infrastructure to support such a large project
3. Degradation of Canterbury City in terms of the ever increasing population and traffic density. The face of Canterbury has changed significantly in the last 10-20 years making it less and less attractive as a place live, shop and visit

Personally, I feel the South East is already over-populated and does not need more buildings, especially on green field sites. Surely it is time for Canterbury City Council to have its own vision of the future, one which meets the needs of the local population rather than numbers imposed by central government for their own ends.
