I am a resident of Whitstable and I wish to strongly object to the proposed housing development at Brooklands Farm. I note the following as areas of concern:-

Our local health services are already over-stretched in regard to dentists, hospitals and GP appointments and with so many proposed new residents this will make matters even worse

There would be a increase in traffic on local roads which are already struggling when driving around the Whitstable area with road closures or traffic lights due to repairs or improvements for things such as water leaks or gas leaks.
