- More pressure on the minor injuries services
- Local flooding in the area – already a major issue in Chestfield when we have heavy rain
- Increase of traffic – the damage to roads and potholes is terrible
- Increase on the sewage – again a major problem.

It is extremely sad to already see so many houses in the area going up for sale to get away from all the work that, less face it, regardless of how many objections you receive, the plan will still go ahead as they always do.
