Dear Local Plan Consultation Team at Canterbury City Council,

I am **John Robson** living at [REDACTED] and I am emailing you my response to the public consultation on the Local Plan specifically regarding the section for the proposed University of Kent development: **Chapter 2, Policy C12**

This proposed development on a large Greenfield site north of and owned by the University of Kent would involve the construction of 2,000 new houses and an increase in local population from around 1,700 to 10,000. Main access points would be through Blean School and near Kent College School causing total chaos in the main road between Canterbury and Whitstable (A290).

This must not be allowed to happen and it is outrageous of the University to contemplate such proposals to solve their own financial problems – all at the expense of their local neighbours.

The development would have devastating effect on the local wildlife, hedgerows and ancient woodland as well as Canterbury's precious green spaces, let alone the extreme danger of the increased traffic.
