Regarding the draft 2040 Canterbury Local Plan, I fully support the environmental strategy outlined. However, I urge for greater emphasis on safeguarding and enhancing the North Downs within the district, including both the Kent Downs National Landscape and its formal 'setting', the North Downs AHLV/LLD.

Scrapping several planned areas surrounding our parish was a prudent decision for several reasons:

Protection of highly productive farmland from destruction.

Conservation of top-quality countryside.

Prevention of pollution to the chalk aquifer, a vital resource for many, including Thanet.

Mitigation of dangers posed by existing road infrastructure.

Avoidance of overloading sewage infrastructure with daily tanker-loads of sewage.

Reduction of pollution risks including air quality and noise, as well as preserving 'dark skies' status.

Preservation of archaeological heritage dating back to the Bronze Age on the old R1 site. Conservation of important wildlife habitats.

Support for City Regeneration and Brownfield Use: We endorse the emphasis on city regeneration and prioritizing brownfield sites over active farmland reflects a sustainable approach to urban development. Utilizing existing urban areas and repurposing brownfield sites can help preserve agricultural land and promote more efficient land use.

Backing Housing Strategy Adjustments: We support for the council's adjustments to the housing strategy, especially the reduction in housing number targets and the removal of "new town" style developments like what was proposed in Adisham. Integrating buses into new developments and improving existing services with the Community Infrastructure Levy funds seems like a practical approach to enhancing public transport accessibility.

The emphasis on walking improvements, such as dropped kerbs and easier crossings, shows a commitment to creating pedestrian-friendly environments, which is essential for fostering active lifestyles and reducing reliance on cars.

Investing in cycling infrastructure, including new lanes and secure lockers, is another positive step toward promoting sustainable modes of transportation. The idea of widening the ring road for cycling lanes while reducing lanes for cars aligns with efforts to prioritize alternative transportation options.

Rail improvements, especially the focus on accessibility at stations like Bekesbourne, are crucial for ensuring that public transport is inclusive and accessible to everyone.

Using Park & Ride sites as delivery hubs demonstrates a creative approach to maximizing their utility beyond just parking, contributing to more efficient and sustainable urban logistics.

Although we are cautious about the new Park & Ride sites but could reassess based on the potential success of other measures.

Overall, it seems like this strategy addresses various aspects of transportation needs while also looking toward future innovations like autonomous vehicles and delivery bots. It will be interesting to see how these plans unfold and the impact they have on the community.

The Parish Council is expressing opposition to this policy on several grounds:

Damage to National Landscape: The expansion is deemed unacceptable due to the significant harm it would cause to the scenic beauty and natural environment of the Kent Downs National Landscape.

Loss of Productive Farmland: The project would result in the loss of valuable agricultural land, which is currently being used for productive farming.

Light Pollution: There are concerns about increased light pollution, especially considering that the nearby business park already contributes significantly to this issue. Without stringent measures, Policy C17 could exacerbate the problem.

Congestion and Safety: Local country lanes are expected to experience increased congestion and become less safe due to the influx of traffic associated with the industrial expansion.

Dependency on Vehicle Transport: The project's heavy reliance on car and lorry transportation contradicts local, national, and international policies, which emphasize the importance of sustainable transportation methods and reducing carbon emissions.

These points collectively highlight the various environmental, social, and policy-related concerns associated with Policy C17 and the proposed industrial expansion at Highland Court Farm.
