As a local residents, we wish to object to the proposed Brooklands Farm Development. I am very concerned about the potential increase in traffic, adding to an already overburdened traffic area & creating more pollution, with the possibility of traffic gridlock at rush hour & a significant increase in traffic on local roads.

Also, it is well known that the existing sewage provision cannot cope with demand & such an increase in housing would put an additional strain on the system, leading to yet more discharging into the sea & rivers. In addition, there would be a higher demand on the water supply, creating the potential for an increase in hosepipe bans in the summer in an area which increasingly experiences drought-like conditions in the height of summer. Conversely in the winter months there can be flash flooding in certain parts of Chestfield & South St. & overdevelopment & insufficient infrastructure would negatively affect this.

Our local health & dental services already struggle to meet demand & would find it difficult to accommodate such an increase in numbers.

We need to protect our farmland, countryside & biodiversity rather than losing it to yet more concrete with, in addition, the consequent negative impact on local wildlife.

For these reasons I object to the Brooklands Farm Development.
