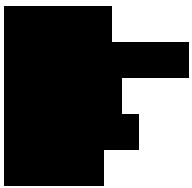

I strongly object to the proposal to build houses on the Bread and Cheese Field.

My concerns are as follows:

A development of this type would remove the Green Space between Westbere and Hersden, effectively merge the two, destroying the individual identities of the villages.

Current infrastructure is already inadequate with insufficient Doctors, Dentists and local shops.

The A28 is already a heavy traffic area, additional houses on the road would increase the problem still further.

The loss of the Field would impact dramatically on the current range of wildlife which inhabits the area or use it for hunting their food.

The Field is of significant historical importance to Westbere with a charitable history that can be traced back over 300 years.

I hope my objection will be seriously considered when taking the decision to grant any building applications related to The Field
