Councillors,

I note that there is a deadline of 5 p.m. 3rd June 2024 for objections to the Brooklands farm development (reference: Brooklands Farm Section – Chapter 3 policy W4)

I OBJECT VERY STRONGLY to this Brooklands Farm housing development – 1400 new homes off South Street, Whitstable.

There is, as far as I can see:

- No provision for additional dentists or other strengthening of the local healthcare
- No parkland or recreation grounds
- No CENTRE (no new small shops, post office, social centre)

The loss of the lovely views over the Brooklands fields will be a great loss to the many people – including myself – who live very near it.

There will be more of some other things:

- Traffic and the associated loss of hugely increased air pollution
- Danger of flooding
- Sewage into what should be water drainage
- Hosepipe bans because of less clean (and more fouled) water
 - DO YOU REALLY THINK WE CAN TRUST SOUTHERN WATER'S PROMISES TO PROVIDE PROPERLY FOR THE ABOVE? THE IDEA IS INSANE!
