The proposed development on the land adjacent to the A257 in Littlebourne must not be given permission for the following reasons;

- 1. It would mean loss of Grade 1 agricultural land. We must produce our own food and not import which adds to pollution, further adding to climate change. Government recently stated agriculture land must be protected.
- 2. The water run-off would impact on water quality of the river Stour, a rare chalk stream.
- 3. Poor capacity of existing village wastewater even without adding a huge number of new dwellings.
- 4. No local work opportunities creating an adverse effect on Littlebourne traffic density along the A257 and Bekesbourne Lane.
- Part of the land is used every day by dog walkers and rambling groups and has done for the 25 years I have lived in the village.
- 6. Excessive urbanisation outside of Littlebourne boundaries.
- 7. Adverse effect on local wildlife and landscape.
