Re: Brooklands farm Development

The above proposal for development is totally ridiculous.

Everywhere we go, be it Maidstone, Sittingbourne, Herne Bay, Canterbury, down to Thanet or simply on our doorstep in Swedecliffe and Whitstable - we are over-run with housing developments.

There is already another proposal for Bodkirk farm on the Thanet Way for 300 houses plus a school.

It's getting like a concrete jungle, the cars already become gridlocked on the roads when approaching junctions and roundabouts.

The noise of traffic is a constant thing.

The one and only sewage farm in Swalecliffe was here over 60 years ago when my Mum moved here.

No wonder with the size of the population that has increased they are illegally contaminating the sea and rivers because the site is unable to cope.

Anyone with any sense can see that would be a problem, but oh no, our fields keep getting crunched up, ruining the habitats for wildlife and the locals just keep seeing more and more fields going.
