History: Over the decades from the days of Whitstable Urban District Council to date I have witnessed some unbelievable approved developments, the majority from Canterbury City Council

Whitstable Sea Street: Vehicles reverse out from their pull ins onto the main throughfare? Further the developers have left the road surface in an appalling state

Herne Bay Esplanade: closed at the Pier, clearly wasn't going to work now several more thousand pounds being spent to reinstate

I strongly disagree with the Brooklands Farm & the Benacre Development: Who are the homes for local people or more imports from the Tower Hamlets?

These plans are ridiculous out of character for the town. With a cumulative increase 50% to the size of the town, roads already cannot cope, a sewage system that is over whelmed even before the water tables became saturated, there are on record unacceptable untreated and regular sewage releases

The supply of water, gas and electricity, landfill, Recycling, pressures on wildlife and public transport, all compounded by current developments off the Thanet Way; Whitstable Heights, Bodkin Farm, Blean, Herne, Altera Park, and further afield at Westwood Cross, Broadstairs and Manston
