I would like to register my objection to build 1400 homes at Brooklands Farm in Whitstable.

We do not have the infrastructure in place. I have recently had to wait over 2 weeks for a Doctor's appointment. It is difficult to recruit Dr's to this area, even with the new medical school at Kent University.

So even if another medical centre was built to service these new homes, it would be useless without the GPs being recruited.

The sewage situation and outflow into the sea would only become worse. Making Whitstable an extremely unsafe place to swim. It would also be less attractive to visitors, who are very important to the local economy.

Flooding would become a more recurrent event, as precious farmland is destroyed.

Traffic congestion and pollution would become worse. We have seen a foretaste of this with the recent repair work on the Thanet Way, forcing traffic onto the old Thanet Way. Traffic around Chestfield has been horrendous.
