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Please add my voice to those who are objecting to the proposed housing development at Brooklands Farm.

Having looked at the proposed development online, I find that it is similar in size to that of Tankerton itself, a housing area built up gradually over the past 90+ years. As others have said, there will be more sewage, more cars, more traffic, more pollution, more flooding, less countryside and impacted wildlife.

I gather that "supporting infrastructure" will be built, but when? At the outset, when it will be needed? As an afterthought when 1,400 more families are in place? (5,000 + people). Or forgotten altogether when the developers have made their profits and left?

With Whitstable Heights and the proposed "Benacre View" opposite it, we will have more than enough (unsold) houses for now, without cutting down the entire area of Longtye Wood and concreting over the larger area of Whitstable as we know it.
