Dear Council,

As a [REDACTED] year long resident of Whitstable, **I OBJECT to Brooklands Farm development**, as I believe our town is already over stretched in its current infrastructure; road traffic, sewage capacity, available school and medical places, etc...

There have been numerous new housing developments in and around our town over the past couple of decades, with some still ongoing. The negative impact is strongly felt by all residents, especially on the increase in traffic congestion!

South Street is one of the only escape routes in Whitstable between the Blean and Tyler Hill roads, to avoid the frequent road closures/road works/road flooding/accidents on both roads.
