To whom it may concern,

I object to the proposed Brooklands Farm development on the following grounds:

- 1) The already overstretched sewerage and drainage systems will be further compromised leading to, as we have seen in the past, the probability of raw sewage being discharged into the sea, particularly after heavy rainfall. The natural soakaway effect of water on open ground will be lost causing localised flooding as is seen frequently on the Thanet Way underpass.
