Dear Sirs.

I strongly object to proposed building of homes at W4 Brooklands farm.

It is alarming that you are prepared to add so many buildings to an already overstretched infrastructure. Our sea & rivers are already highly polluted by sewage & have the highest overflows in the County which are being investigated by the Environment agency. It is anticipated that this development will create 420 Tonnes of water & sewage every day being released .Our sewage system is at capacity. The extension of the sewage pipe into our seas is a cover to the real need to increase capacity to treat the sewage in the first place. The health & wellbeing of residents, swimmers & all water sport users is being severely compromised. Before considering more building in the area this provision must be created. Let Brixham & SW water be a warning.

Additionally, loss of valuable green space and natural habitat will impact the character of the town and the wellbeing of residents. Wildlife will be replaced with concrete & flooding.

Increased traffic congestion, which is already an issue, will be worse and the provision of sufficient healthcare and emergency services will also be affected.
