I would like to add my name to the many that have already sent in objections to the proposed development of the Brooklands Farm Site.

There are so many reasons for this development not to go ahead but I have listed my main concerns below:

The increase in air pollution is a rising concern in general and with increased traffic flow the level of air pollution will rise, causing an even greater impact on the health of locals and wildlife.
