### --Email From External Account--

Such increased population north of Canterbury would have a disastrous effect on the already fast and overcrowded main road known as St Stephen's Hill, at and near CT2 7AT. It is already dangerous for pedestrians to cross St Stephen's Hill to reach the post-box and bus-stop to Canterbury on the other side of the road, especially residents and their relatives dependent on wheelchairs or with small children in pushchairs. In addition a quite long stretch of pavement, on the west side of the road between the Archbishop's School and Hackington Close, is scarcely wide enough for pushchairs and wheelchairs, with neighbouring gardens gradually trying to creep across it, with the effect of forcing pedestrians young and old to within a few inches of the already considerable traffic that drives fast up the hill. The proposed new development would undoubtedly make what is already a dangerous situation for pedestrians very much worse.

We do not need hundreds (let alone thousands) more people and their cars using this road as a route between the proposed new development and central Canterbury.
