I am writing to formally object to Policy W4 Brooklands Farm. Whitstable and Tankerton are already experiencing some of the most extensive raw sewage releases in England. Despite promises made at town hall meetings I have attended, Southern Water have not only not fulfilled their promises to significantly increase treatment capacity, releases have actually dramatically increased. The council's primary responsibility should be the health and safety of local residents. My children and I have already been made sick from going in the 'so called' excellent local bathing water (independent testing finding high levels of E.coli). This development would undoubtedly increase raw sewage releases, and can therefore not be approved until substantial new treatment works and infrastructure are built. The development also needs to be considered in the context of other substantial housing plans, which make this proposed develop even less feasible in terms of required sewage treatment capacity and infrastructure.
