To whom it may concern I wish to register my objection to Policy W4 Brooklands Farm.

There is a significant risk to flooding at Brooklands and downstream in Chestfield and Swalecliffe if the current land is turned into a large sprawling housing development.

Swalecliffe treatment works is already unable to cope with the volume of water it has to process and there are unacceptable numbers of times when raw sewerage is allowed to be released into the sea due to the constraints on the current treatment works. Any further increase in housing is going to acerbate this issue and allow our sea to become a dumping ground for waste.
