We wish to strongly object to the Council's proposal to build 2,000 houses on green belt land between Tyler Hill, Blean and Rough Common including Blean Woods which is one of the last remaining ~~ancient~~ ^{ancient} woods in the south east.

It will put far too much pressure on current infra-structure. We are particularly concerned at the prospect of 2,000 homes creating at least another 3,000 cars on our already congested roads. Surely there are enough brown field sites in and around Canterbury for smaller

sustainable less damaging developments.

Once a green field and woodland is covered in concrete it can never be replaced.
