

Reference Plans R7 + R8.

We are deffinatly against any more building in this area.

Road use for Bekebourne lane through to BRIDGE, Plus Jubilee Rd, Nargate Street going upto Court Hill and past have been already. Not only from existing new homes built, but, fall out from Whigham, Ash Woodnesborough and Aylesham New Builds coming through and around Littlebourne.

Refuse Collection, Ambulances and local farming equipment are finding it hard to get through.

With most houses having two vehicles, parking is problematic already. The amount of homes planned for R7 + R8 will bring even more cars to the area which resources can't cope with. Along with water, sewage problems that are already affecting the village and waterways. The chalk stream is so important these days and farming land are needed more than ever, especially due to climate change where lots of farming land is flooded.

R7 farming land is vital especially a Grade 1 growing Area.

R7 + R8 would also destroy wild life that continue to use these areas.

The fact that there is no employment in Littlebourne Area also means more and more car usage for travelling to work and school runs, which in turn adds to the pollution.

People using Bekebourne lane walking to Howletts Zoo have found it so dangerous due to over usage increase. There is no room for foot paths, plus the road it self is in awful state due to increase in vehicle use.

Littlebourne High Street, entries into and out of Littlebourne are getting more traffic from New Housing Estates from Whigham, Ever growing Aylesham.

Inadequate water and sewage system already causing damage to Littlebourne and the environment. The plans do not meet with sustainable development standards. Pumping into the Little Stour and Tankers transporting Sewage to Canterbury Works is also a big concern. Infrastructure plans for sewage, School, GP Surgery are also so important, but, will they be implemented at all. House are being built without all the necessary thought for now and the future. With over exploitation of Littlebourne and surrounding area, the whole of Kent together with wild life, rivers etc are being destroyed.
