I would like to commend the Council on the broad aims behind the strategic outlook alluded to within the Draft Local Plan. I appreciate your difficulties producing a plan which everyone agrees with. However, I would like to voice my concerns about Policy SS4 regarding the Movement and Transportation Strategy for the District.

I realise that the plan is currently bereft of any great detail but I would be very concerned about any plan to use Rough Common Road as a link route to reduce traffic flow into the city. Rough Common is a village despite already suffering from excess traffic who use the road as a cut through. Converting Rough Common Road to a link route would in my opinion effectively end the existence of Rough Common as a village.

I urge the Council to reconsider any proposals regarding the above.
