Dear Sirs

We have resided in Rough Common, Canterbury for over 30 years, and during that time we have experienced both good and very bad days involving the movement of traffic through the village. The village shop has little parking which means that customers have to park on the road causing tailbacks for passing through vehicles.

Due to limited parking for many houses in the village some residents have to park on the road this also applies to visiting guests and relatives, the idea of making Rough Common Road a part of the ring road fills us with horror.

The existing road is not wide enough to accommodate the proposed increase in traffic flow. There are sections of road that cannot be widened and would increase the bottle neck situation.

It is hoped the City and County Council will think long and hard before they waste any further tax payers money on such a foolish scheme that will ultimately not be undertaken like so many previous ideas.
