Good evening.

I am e mailing to voice my objection to the planned estate on Brookland's Farm. It is already impossible to get an appointment with your own doctor. If this estate is built we will end up with even more people, making it even harder to get the medical care that local people need, Why are these houses being built, when we already struggle enough as it is? It will make the roads much busier, making it much harder for people to get to wherever they want to go. The roads are already congested enough as it is.

There are already not enough schools, high waiting lists in hospitals, delays for people who are waiting for urgent operations, not enough hospital beds, patients who cannot be discharged from hospital, due to strains on the social care system, and difficulties getting an ambulance in an emergency, due to the current strain on the health service.

In addition to this, what is going to happen about the drainage system ? it already floods in this area now, especially in Ham Shades Lane, and on the Thanet Way. If this estate is built, it will make the situation even worse.

It will be catastrophic when we are already well over capacity at the present time. It will only exacerbate the current problems.

I would urge you, in the strongest terms, not to proceed with this plan.
