To whom it may concern,

I have recently been notified that the Canterbury City Council is planning to build a new (and big) estate on Brooklands Farm. This news is most worrying, so I would like to take this opportunity to object for the subsequent reasons:

- 1 - I object because there are already many homes and houses (as well as organisations) in the local vicinity (an additional development is problematic).
- 2 - I object due to this lessening the number (and quality) of "natural" areas (farmland and clean space) in the community.
- 3 - I object, since this will alleviate the charm of the local area - changing a once-beautiful place into an unnecessarily developed region.
- 4 - I object due to increased environmental worries and problems, like the rising noise pollution from vehicles and properties.
- 5 - I object, since there is a strong chance of the buildings being different (and not fitting) to the existing ones in the area (changing history and traditions).
- 6 - I object, as there are more problems pertaining to the hazardous substances impacting the "at-risk" members of the local population (e.g., the disabled).
- 7 - I object because of the strain that will be caused to the likes of GP surgeries, schools, and roads with this new community of residents.

In short, I am very concerned about this issue. I hope that this message can be used in tandem with other concerns to stop this proposed housing development from going ahead.
