It has come to my attention that the Canterbury City Council is planning to construct a large-scale estate on Brooklands Farm. I cannot sufficiently express my disappointment in receiving this news, so would like to object for the following reasons:

1 - I object due to the housing being built on green space, surely, we can use brown land or landfill areas for housing instead. This is prime farmland which could be used to sustain our country should we enter a war like the Ukraine and need to feed ourselves.

2 - I object because this will reduce the amount of "green areas" in the community and there are trees over 100s of years old.

3 - I object, as this will tarnish the beauty of the local area - reducing clean space, being an "eye sore" for onlookers, and so on.

4 - I object due to added environmental problems, e.g., a loss of trees and vegetation, noise pollution, and beyond.

5- I object as this will significantly change the boundaries of the villages and they will become joined rather than 2 distinct places with greenbelt between.

6 - I object, as there is a significant risk of the buildings being out-of-sync with the charm of the existing architecture.

7 - I object because there are increased problems pertaining to the hazardous materials affecting the vulnerable members of the local area.

8 - I object, as the infrastructure of the local area may not be able to keep up-to-speed with the influx of new residents (GPs, roads, schools, etc.).

In closing, I am most disappointed with this news. I can only hope that this letter of objection outlines my strong feelings towards this proposed housing development.
