Not more houses! There are already too many houses either under construction (Whitstable Heights - 400 houses) or proposed (Benacre View - 270 houses + Park & Bus facility and now 120 houses at Golden Hill. Also, the future possible development at Brooklands Farm. There won't be any green spaces left between Whitstable and Herne Bay on the A2990 (Old Thanet Way).

The amount of traffic on the A2990 is going to be a major concern as it is already a busy road and trying to negotiate turning right from Golden Hill is already extremely difficult. Without proper infrastructure in place, no further building should take place.

Kent was once the Garden of England but I don't think it will be much longer with the amount of building taking place on valuable agricultural land.
