Dear Canterbury City Council,

This is to express my objection to the Canterbury City Draft Local Plan, Policy SS4.

The proposition to re-route traffic to and from the northern half of the City through Rough Common will have an extremely detrimental effect on the lives of the residents of the village and would be environmentally damaging at a time when we are all being encouraged to try to save the environment against global warming. At present, there is a vehicle weight limit of 7.5 Tons, with 9 junctions serving housing and a busy nature reserve and a tenth housing development junction awaiting planning approval. Several of these junctions have very limited sight-lines when entering Rough Common Road and would be made more dangerous with the increased traffic flow.

I also wish to oppose the Proposed Zone Scheme. I think it is most inappropriate for city the size of Canterbury. A reliable public transport system along with a much larger Park and Ride to the south of the city, could be served by the A2 and from a new east/west link from Sturry.

This possibly could be an alternative solution.
