I oppose this plan, in particular the routing of North Canterbury traffic through Rough Common

The proposal is unworkable, irresponsible and ruinously costly as to expense, precious local amenity and the impact on hundreds of lives.

Funnelling traffic from many to one roads defies common sense, especially when that road is no better than a rat-run and would need widening at the expense of many houses and gardens through compulsory purchase orders. Sometimes the greater good CAN trump the loss to a few, but the few is in fact the residential many and the good illusory.

Giles Lane and Rough Common boast housing and heritage that don't deserve such Corporation vandalism all for a concentration of congestion that will leave commuters worse off by far. Pedestrians and schoolchildren would also suffer totally unwarranted disturbance and risk.
