As a resident of Rough Common I have been invited to give my feedback on the Draft Local Plan and its impact on the City, its residents and the community of Rough Common specifically.

You have given no thought to the demographic make up of Rough Common and Harbledown with its ageing population. Ignoring the transient student population, it's also probably true of the rest of the City of Canterbury as well.
