Dear Canterbury City Councillors,

I am a resident of [REDACTED] & I wish to give my response to Canterbury City Council's draft local plan. If this goes ahead the lives of Rough Common residents will be very badly effected. We will face a long drive even to shop for essentials or visit Doctors surgeries etc. This at a time when we are all being urged to be "greener".

The upgrading of Rough Common Road would have a devastating impact on everyday life for villagers. The volume of traffic on Rough Common Road is already high. Getting a vehicle off a driveway is difficult & slow all day but particularly in the morning & evening rush. It can be very dangerous unless a thoughtful motorist stops & gives way.

The noise level is already high from around 6am until 10pm. An increase to this would be intolerable & badly effect residents sleeping & their mental health.
