I am strenuously opposed to this proposed development on social and environmental and historical grounds.

1. The main reason for the EMC appears to be to enable the zoning proposal. The grounds for the zoning proposal are weak and subject to wide opposition. Without the zoning proposal there would be no need for the EMC.
2. The EMC proposal is likely to cost at least £300 million - money which would be better spent on improvements to public transport to reduce reliance on car use.
3. If the EMC were to go ahead, it would bring gridlock to the already congested A28.
4. The proposed route would cut Fordwich in half and would destroy a rich natural environment. It would also require an archeological investigation. It would be far better to find an alternative route now, rather than be forced into one later.
5. In the worst case scenario that the EMC goes ahead, I believe that a modified route could be found, which avoids some of the more serious environmental, social and historical consequences.
