Dear Sir/Madam,

I believe the deadline for objecting to the Eastern Movement Corridor for the local residents has been extended to Monday, 13th February. Please accept my email as an objection to the proposed Easter bypass.

In my opinion the proposed Eastern Movement Corridor will:

- destroy over 50 acres of mature woodland and a good quality agricultural land

- prevent wildlife from roaming freely between existing woodland,

- destroy existing footpaths and nationally recognized cycling routes,

- increase light, noise, and air pollution,

- cut the Fordwich community into two,

- prevent delivery/waste collection lorries from accessing the town (the existing bridges in Fordwich don't allow any vehicles wider than 6' 6" to pass)

- potentially "help" future developers to obtain approvals for building new housing estates next to the bypass.

I would like to ask the council to consider modifications of the proposed route.
