Good morning,

I would like to comment please specifically on the proposals for new housing at Rattington Street and the old Paper Mill in Chartham.

Paper Mill - of the two sites, this seems more intuitive, but the idea of 125 houses on the site seems very excessive. I think the land which is already used, and the row of derelict cottages, could be used but for far fewer houses. One would also need to consider the impact on the river, and the green spaces there, and to consider how difficult access already is for traffic.

Rattington Street - I do not believe houses should be built here at all, encroaching on the countryside. Again, access would be an issue, and in addition I do not think Chartham has the infrastructure for so many new houses.
