In relation to the question "do you have any comments on the proposed deletion of land north of the University of Kent (Policy C12), I'm delighted and grateful that the council has listened to the concerns of local people.

The impact on already-clogged local roads would have been enormous, leading to more rat runs especially along Rough Common Road. The destruction of ancient woodland would have been devastating - once done, we could never go back. The demolition of Blean school, once a very successful school for local children but seems to be expanding its catchment area all the time, would have also caused concern.

These objections would be the same for any future proposal for a large housing development on University land, and I hope that will be taken into consideration.
