I wish to reiterate all the objections that have been made previously which have led to deletion of the above policy from the local plan. These were mainly the same objections which I made in my original statement and will continue to make should the policy ever be reconsidered in the local plan. These objections being: destruction of ancient woodland with its many animals, plants, birds and trees + damage to the Sarre Penn which flows through the area. In addition, construction of a large roundabout at the junction with Rough Common to create access to the site would result in major traffic problems, given that each of 2000 new houses could have 2 cars. Added to the above, currently there are massive difficulties getting GP and dentist appointments in the area.

As a resident of Tyler Hill, I can't thank our councillors enough for listening to our concerns. Meanwhile, I hope there is never again a future for C21 and that it is forever buried, never to be resurrected again.
