I am responding to the question of whether I have any comments on the **proposed deletion of Land north of the University of Kent (Policy C12)** from the local plan.

I was so very relieved to hear of the proposed deletion of this land (C12) as I had been very worried indeed that the proposal might go ahead. I agree completely with the reasons that the proposal was deleted, especially the destruction of ancient woodland and the effect of such a development on the road network. The fear of the very much increased road traffic has been haunting me as I make my daily early morning walk on roads around my home in Tyler Hill. The reasons for deleting the C12 development proposal – a very large development - are not only valid now but will continue to be valid in the future.
