I live locally on Ashford Road and pass the Thanington Recreation ground and Neighbourhood Centre regularly.

It is obvious that these facilities are in constant use by a wide range of community members, especially young people and children.

Thanington has been officially recognised as an area lacking in green space and it would be disastrous for the current and future communities if this was lost forever.
