I wish to add my support in relation to ***“Do you have any comments on the proposed deletion of land North of the University of Kent (Policy C12)”***

It was excellent news to hear of the councils proposal to delete the land north of UKC as specified in Policy C12 of the local plan. Thankfully the councillors have listened to the concerns of local residents and have appreciated the hugely damaging impact on the local environment if this land had been developed.

It is clear that any development of this land, now or in future, would result in significant damage to the “Blean” ancient woodland and the excellent conservation work taking place.
