I write as a resident of the Canterbury district to formally object to the proposal that Thanington recreation ground be concreted over as an alternative Wincheap Park & Ride.

To even suggest this as a viable idea is in my opinion both shameful and offensive. To permanently erase the relatively small and only green space in the Thanington area, and to almost certainly risk the future of Thanington Resource Centre, which is working with one of the top areas of deprivation in the UK is at best absurd and totally incongruous. This is especially when it flies in the face of current CCC and Government policies, ideologies and sustainability. It is even more disgraceful that it is a Labour led authority at the heart of it.
