I agree with the deletion of the local plan policy C12 (to build 2,000 houses in the locality of the villages of Blean and Tyler Hill to the north of The University of Kent). In this email I am responding to the following question: Do you have any comments on the proposed deletion of Land for building north of the University of Kent (Local Plan Policy C12)?

I strongly agree with the reasons given for this deletion. They accord with those given in my letter sent to Canterbury City Council a year or so ago. They include concerns that local infrastructure will be overwhelmed by Policy C12 and that valuable local flora and fauna will be lost as a result of devastating and irreversible pressure of additional traffic and needs of additional population.
