Policy N23

The Joseph Wilson Business Park already covers a large area and the latest units have only recently been completed. The Travis Perkins unit and yard which is an eyesore and floodlit at night, was supposed to have trees and shrubs around the perimeter, but nothing has ever been planted!

The proposed Business/employment units would be built on prime agricultural land - surely a brownfield site could be found elsewhere.

It makes me very sad to see this area changing so much, not just here, the whole of Kent!
