I am writing to record my opposition to the planned destruction of the Thanington Recreation Ground. This facility is essential to the Thanington Resource Centre who have done a brilliant job in providing for the families and youngsters and reducing crime in the area and they need the green space to continue this provision.

Traffic-wise a park and ride will not work on that side of the bridge. The buses and vehicles will not be able to get out of the site. Already there is queueing traffic most of the day as a result of the traffic lights at St. Nicholas Road (a big mistake - a roundabout would have been sufficient for the small amount of traffic coming out of there plus the estate has its own purpose built road onto the bridge). Traffic coming off the yet to be built slip road would have to come back across the bridge to the site only adding to the traffic queues backing up through Wincheap

Thanington residents need the green space for their well being and they deserve to have it as they are suffering high levels of pollution as a result of previous decisions that have caused the continuous standing traffic queues (which will get even worse when further house building happens in this area).
