I have lived in Whitstable for 35 years and was raised in the surrounding area. The council and local Government have no interest or respect for the residents of Whitstable. In recent years there has been a rapid decline in the quality of our environment. Unsafe bathing, mains water issues, increased crime and continual road works (but still the roads and pavements are shoddy and in need of repair). The road where I live is the second main route into Whitstable and it was closed for six months from last January and many months the year before. The amount of traffic is ridiculous and unsafe on such a narrow road. Daily policing is mostly non-existent, drug dealers thrive and burglaries continue.

We do not need more building and we certainly do not need gypsy/traveller pitches. Whitstable does not need to be 're-imagined', it was fine before. We need the council to provide fundamental services, maintain the infrastructure and keep us safe. That's your whole job and lately, you've not been doing it too well. You need to do better before you can expect us to have any confidence in your plans and schemes.
